Vocational guidance “Try out a profession”

2. COUNTRY

Lithuania

3. SPECIFIC GOALS

Vocational guidance refers to a range of activities that enable students from grades 5-12 to actively become acquainted with various areas of employment, career opportunities and peculiarities, to gain work experience, and to develop professional motivation and plan their future career. Vocational guidance consists of these three pillars:

- a) Study visits to companies, institutions and organisations
- b) Vocational guidance trial visits – students’ assistantships/traineeships
- c) Intensive vocational guidance (internships, other professional activities of a duration longer than 2 days)

4.1. Who (Provider)

Ministry of education and science of the republic of Lithuania
Lithuanian centre of non-formal youth education
Sectoral practical training centres, equipped with modern practical training facilities for one or several branches of industry

4.2. To whom (Target group)

Students of grades 5-12

Students can get to know the specificities of their chosen profession and the tools used, speak to students of that specialty, attempt to carry out practical tasks, develop basic skills required at the work place.

These activities help the student make a decision regarding their future studies and career.
