It provides a framework for **joint innovative projects among partners**. It is the base for training centers to involve students in the creation and development of real and sustainable projects related to the curriculum on an international footprint. EROVET Together provides a protocol (steps to follow) and documents to (templates) that will facilitate the development, the prototyping for such work, as well as the evaluation of the projects. To create a clear and easy development it is necessary to establish a **protocol** with the steps we will follow to proceed with the collaboration projects:



First, partners evolve a **networking** communication that is based on exchanging ideas and information with both teachers and students with shared interests, these relationships are developed for mutual benefit, which is to develop a collaborative project. In simple words, we pretend to make contacts through a process





that is two-way by students from different countries. Once we have shared our ideas, we create **teams** according to similar interests, which will be coordinated by an assigned mentor. Then, to regulate the relationship of collaborators working on a project together, a **collaboration agreement** template was created.

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Fifth. Issuance of reports

Both persons in charge of the project will inform the other part about the progress of the tasks being developed.

On completion of the project all participants of this collaboration agreement will issue a final report with the conclusions gathered.

Sixth. Confidentiality

Each of the parties guarantees not to disseminate, under any circumstance, any scientific or technical information to which they may have had access for the development of the project and which belongs to the other party, to the extent that such information is not in the public domain.

Results, reports as well as final outcomes shall remain confidential during the execution of the project. Should one of the parties have the need to make use of the partial or final result, they will have to request a signed permission from the other party.

Both educational institutions commit not to disclose to third parties the fact of being performing the services of the development and manufacturing of the project of *Project name* for the company.

Seventh: Liability resulting from breaching the confidentiality

In the event that the School or any of its managers, staff and/or legal representatives breaches the commitment of confidentiality undertaken under this agreement, they will assume responsibility for damage caused by such infringement.

Eighth: Jurisdiction

Parties are committed to amicably resolve any kind of disagreement that may arise during the development of this contract.

Arbitration award and probate will be carried out in the city of both centers.
